October Texas Hold'em

Working at area Charity Poker events (what we refer to as "Texas Hold'em") is our Council's largest fundraiser. At these events, hosted at various licensed venues, our Council members serve as "the bank". This year, we have secured a new gaming location - Wintergarden Tavern, on the west side of Gratiot Ave, between M-59 (Hall Rd) and 21 Mile Rd. [Click on the attachment below for a map.](#)

We do not participate in the games being played at the tables. Instead, we take in cash and hand out poker chips to players, then later "cash out" those players when they return with chips. Once an hour, we collect accumulated funds, called a "rake", from the dealer at each table. We also log all transactions into a computer.

Manna Meals

Our Council's been asked if we can find a few Knights to help out at a Manna Meals event on **Saturday, September 3.**

For those unfamiliar with this event, members of our Council periodically drive down to Detroit on Saturday mornings to help Father Lumpkin serve the poor and homeless in the Corktown area of the city. Years ago, Father gave up being pastor of a local parish so he could establish and run a program to feed and clothe the poor of Detroit; he's now been at this for over 40 years. Five days a week, every week of the year, Father Lumpkin and volunteers from around the Detroit area make and serve meals to the homeless from the basement of St. Peter's Episcopal Church, at the corner of Michigan & Trumbull (yes, that's correct, right where the old Tiger Stadium stood). Sometimes this is PB&J sandwiches, sometimes bologna & cheese sandwiches, usually mac & cheese, and always bean soup. And all this is donated by local restaurants, groceries and other organizations.
